HISTOPATHOLOGY REPORT

CLINICAL NOTES:

Sigmoid polyp. Histology.

MACROSCOPIC

Labelled sigmoid polyp. An ovoid brown smooth pedunculated polyp 6 x 5 x 4 mm with an attached stalk 3 mm in length and 4 mm in diameter. Trisected LS. A1 (sl)

MICROSCOPIC:

The biopsy consists of polypoid mucosa showing changes consistent with mucosal prolapse/prominent mucosal fold; the changes include mild lamina propria hypercellularity and light fibrosis, relatively evenly spaced straight crypts showing reactive change and mild mucin depletion, and thickening of the underlying muscularis mucosae. There is no significant hyperplastic change and no evidence of dysplasia or invasive malignancy.

CONCLUSION:

Sigmoid polyp - Benign; changes in keeping with mucosal prolapse/prominent mucosal fold.
